Starting as early as Monday, April 29, CDHI utility relocation work will require the closure of the south lanes of 6 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street SW, including a partial closure of the intersection of 6 Avenue and 3 Street SW.



What is the work? CDHI Utility Relocation – 6 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street SW.

As early as Monday, April 29, a closure of the south lanes of 6 Avenue will begin to accommodate CDHI utility relocation work.

- Closure of south sidewalk and south lanes of 6 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street SW.
- Closure of south lanes of 6 Avenue between 3 and 4 Street SW.
- No southbound traffic on 3 Street SW south of 6 Avenue

- Pedestrian detours will be in place.
- Access to loading docks and parkades maintained assisted by flaggers.

This project will also require weekend full road closures of 6 Avenue between 2 and 4 Street SW, and of 3 Street SW south of 6 Avenue, specific construction notices will be issued.

About Green Line LRT

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$5.5 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
