2 Street S.W. | Complete Street Project

After getting feedback from the community, The City of Calgary has a final design for the 2 Street S.W. Complete Street Project. During both phases of engagement held in June 2018, and November 2018, we heard that there was a desire from the community for protected on-street cycling facilities, and a desire to maintain two-way traffic on 2 Street S.W.

Join us on October 30, 2019 between 5:30 and 8:30 p.m. at the Cliff Bungalow-Mission Community Centre to see the design and speak to the project team.

2 Street and 17 Avenue S.W. intersection

The design includes a cycle track on the east and west side of 2 Street S.W., curb extension at seven intersections, and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) at three intersections for safer pedestrian crossing, and a new traffic signal at 2 Street and 13 Avenue S.W.
