How to protect your vehicle and belongings:

- 1. Lock all doors and close all windows.
- 2. In the summer, ensure your sunroof is closed or your convertible top is up.
- **3.** Do not leave a spare key hidden inside the vehicle.
- **4.** Do not leave your vehicle running while unattended.
- Park in well-lit, designated parking areas, and avoid unlit areas at night.
- Never leave valuables or money in your vehicle.
- 7. Know what your key fob can do, and what its limits are. Can someone start your car if the fob is close by?
