2nd Quarter 2024 Statistical Report

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Executive Summary

- Total violent crime in the 2nd Quarter was 18% above the 5-year average and in line volume in the 2nd Quarter of 2023. Assaults increased 21% in the 2nd Quarter with above average volumes noted across several assault types.
- There were four homicides during the 2nd Quarter of 2024, 33% down from average. One of the four homicides were domestic-motivated.
- Reported sexual offences were 5% below average in the 2nd Quarter and 19% below volume in Q2 2023.
- There was a 22% increase of robberies in the 2nd Quarter driven mostly by more commercial robberies than average.
- The presence of weapons in violent crime was 18% higher than the 5-year average during the 2nd Quarter with increases noted across multiple weapon types (with the exception of firearms).
- The number of victims of domestic violence increased 22% in the 2nd Quarter from the 5-year average.
- Property crime volumes were 14% below the 5-year average in the 2nd Quarter of 2024 with noteworthy declines of most property crime types with the exception of fraud.
- The total number of young offenders identified was 13% higher than the 5-year average during the 2nd Quarter with increases across most violent types (except a 27% decrease of robberies). Property crime increased 23% with most property crime types noting an increase above average.
- There was a 21% increase above average of youth victims of violent crimes during the 2nd Quarter but a similar volume to the 2nd Quarter of 2023.
- The total number of police service requests during the 2nd Quarter was 2% above the five-year average. Police attended an average of 1009 calls a day. This is 4% below the 5-year average.
- Citizen use of the online reporting system was 14% higher than the 5-year average during the 2nd Quarter, with 57 reports per day.
- Disorder calls accounted for an average of 221 calls per day from the public during the 2nd Quarter of 2024. There was a 17% reduction in the 2nd Quarter of 2024 compared to the five-year average with declines noted across most disorder call types.

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REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report is derived from the Calgary Police Service records management system (SENTRY). Disorder data is derived from the Computer aided Dispatch (CAD) system. Data is compiled by the Corporate Data and Analytics Team of the Bureau of Service & Community Support.

Reporting is based on the most serious offence in the incident. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence was *reported*, which is not necessarily the month the offence occurred. The reported date is the first point in time at which the police were notified of the offence and reporting lag may vary due to circumstances (these are typically property crimes where the victim did not report the offence until a later date, or was unaware of the loss until a later date, or late-reported sexual assaults). Also note that “attempted” offences are included in these totals. Violent crime, excluding robbery, is counted by the number of victims, using the most serious offence against the victim. Robbery, and all other crime, is counted by incident using the most serious offence in the incident. Of note, cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearance rates for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases “cleared by charge” and those “cleared otherwise” are included in these clearance rate totals.

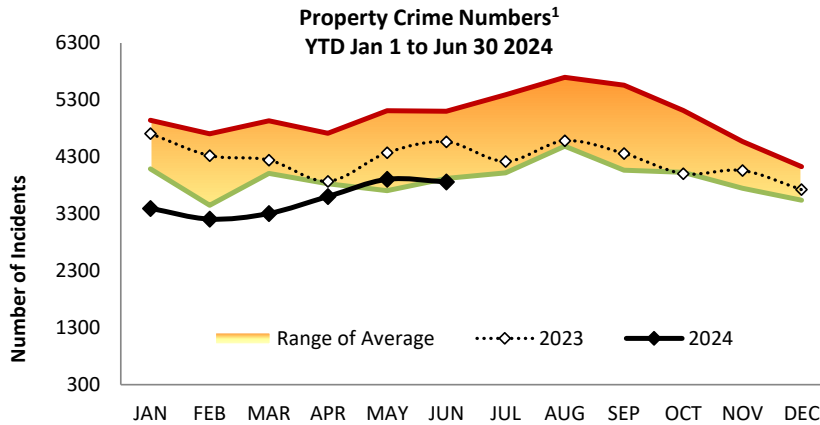

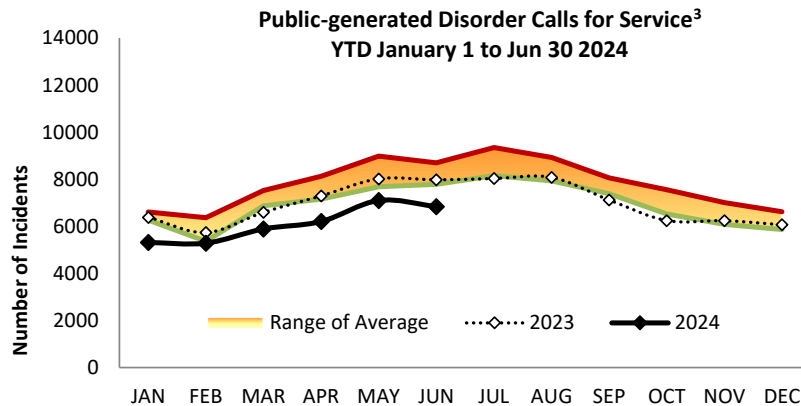

The implementation of the new provincial legislation (Provincial Administrative Penalties Act) has resulted in a significant reduction in impaired offences under the Criminal Code as most first time impaired drivers will be subject to only an IRS:FAIL (the specific administrative penalty under the Traffic Safety Act for criminal level impaired driving offences), unless the incident results in death or serious bodily harm or other significant aggravating factors in which case criminal charges should also be pursued.
