# 3rd Quarter 2024 Statistical Report

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## Executive Summary

- Total violent crime in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter was 17% above the 5-year average and 7% above volume in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2023. Assaults increased 18% in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter with above average volumes noted across several assault types.
- There were five homicides during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2024 (comparable to the 5-year average). One of the five homicides were domestic-motivated.
- Reported sexual offences were 5% above average in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter and 3% below volume year-to-date.
- There was a 12% increase of robberies in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter driven by more commercial robberies than average.
- The presence of weapons in violent crime was 18% higher than the 5-year average during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter with increases noted across multiple weapon types (with the exception of firearms).
- The number of victims of domestic violence increased 21% in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter from the 5-year average.
- Property crime volumes were 17% below the 5-year average in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2024 with noteworthy declines across most property crime types.
- The total number of young offenders identified was 19% higher than the 5-year average during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter with increases across most violent types. Property crime increased 6% (driven mostly by a notable increase of B&E activity).
- There was a 12% increase above average of youth victims of violent crimes during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter with increases of robbery and assault youth victims.
- The total number of police service requests during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter was 2% above the five-year average. Police attended an average of 1047 calls a day. This is 2% below the 5-year average.
- Citizen use of the online reporting system was 14% higher than the 5-year average during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter, with 64 reports per day.
- Disorder calls accounted for an average of 244 calls per day from the public during the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2024. There was an 11% reduction in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter of 2024 compared to the five-year average with declines noted across most disorder call types. Abandoned Auto calls for service increased 47% in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter.

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## REPORT NOTES

Most of the statistical data in this report is derived from the Calgary Police Service records management system (SENTRY). Disorder data is derived from the Computer aided Dispatch (CAD) system. Data is compiled by the Corporate Data and Analytics Team of the Bureau of Service & Community Support.

Reporting is based on the most serious offence in the incident. Please note that offences are assigned to the month in which the offence was *reported*, which is not necessarily the month the offence occurred. The reported date is the first point in time at which the police were notified of the offence and reporting lag may vary due to circumstances (these are typically property crimes where the victim did not report the offence until a later date, or was unaware of the loss until a later date, or late-reported sexual assaults). Also note that “attempted” offences are included in these totals. Violent crime, excluding robbery, is counted by the number of victims, using the most serious offence against the victim. Robbery, and all other crime, is counted by incident using the most serious offence in the incident. Of note, cases are often cleared months and sometimes years later. Consequently, clearance rates for previous years may appear to be much higher than those of the present year. Cases “cleared by charge” and those “cleared otherwise” are included in these clearance rate totals.
