What is the work? City of Calgary Utility Relocation – 5 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street S.W.

The City of Calgary will be working on the relocation of water infrastructure.

- Closure of four south lanes of 5 Avenue west of 2 SW as of Friday, April 26.
- The closure will continue until Monday, April 29.
- No on-street parking.
- Access to loading docks will be maintained.
