


4 Avenue Lane Closures

Notice Date: June 11, 2024

Starting as early as June 17, 2024, the north two lanes of 4 Avenue will be closed between 1 and 3 Street SW to accommodate ATCO's utility abandonment work.

What is the work? ATCO Utility Abandonment – 4 Avenue between 1 and 3 Street SW

The closure of the two north lanes of 4 Avenue is required to accommodate ATCO's utility abandonment work.

- Work will occur on the north two lanes of 4 Avenue at either side of 2 Street SW.
- No impacts are expected to the sidewalk or crosswalks.
- Lane tapering will begin just east of 1 Street SW.
- On-street parking will not be allowed on the north side of 4 Avenue while the construction is in progress.
- Two-way traffic will remain on both 1 Street SW and 2 Street SW.

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$5.5 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
