

Cable Pulling Lane Closures

Notice Date: July 12, 2024

Beginning July 16, a series of lane closures on 6, 5, 4, and 3 Avenue will be installed to support cable pulling for Telus. This will include a daytime closure on July 22. All other closures indicated below are scheduled between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.

What is the work? Cable Pulling to Support New Telus Infrastructure

This is a series of one-to-three day lane closures. No road or intersection closures are required.

- On July 22, the southern parking lane on 3 Avenue will be closed from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- All other closures listed in the notice will be performed between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$5.5 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
