




Green Leaf Demolition - 1612 Centre Street N

As early as Tuesday, August 6, 2024, Green Line will begin mobilizing to the site for the demolition of the Green Leaf building. Demolition will include interior stripping and abatement, followed by the structural demolition, foundation removal, backfill, and grading.

What is the work? Green Leaf Demolition – 1612 Centre Street N

Green Line will begin mobilizing to the Green Leaf site on Tuesday, August 6, 2024. Demolition will begin with interior stripping and abatement. Once completed, structural demolition will begin, followed by foundation removals, backfill, and grading.

What to expect?

- Increased truck traffic in the area.
- Weather permitting, work will occur Monday to Saturday, 7am-5pm.
- While mitigations will be in place, there may be dust, soil, and debris in the area.
- Construction can be noisy, and vibrations may be felt during work hours.

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$6.2 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Shepard to Eau Claire.
