### **What is the work? Mustard Seed Demolition – 104 and 106 11 Avenue S.W.**

Green Line will begin mobilizing to the Mustard Seed site on Tuesday, August 6, 2024. Demolition will begin with interior stripping and abatement. Once completed, structural demolition will begin, followed by foundation removals, backfill, and grading.

### **What to expect?**

- Increased truck traffic in the area.
- Weather permitting, work will occur Monday to Saturday, 7am-5pm.
- While mitigations will be in place, there may be dust, soil, and debris in the area.
- Construction can be noisy, and vibrations may be felt during work hours.
