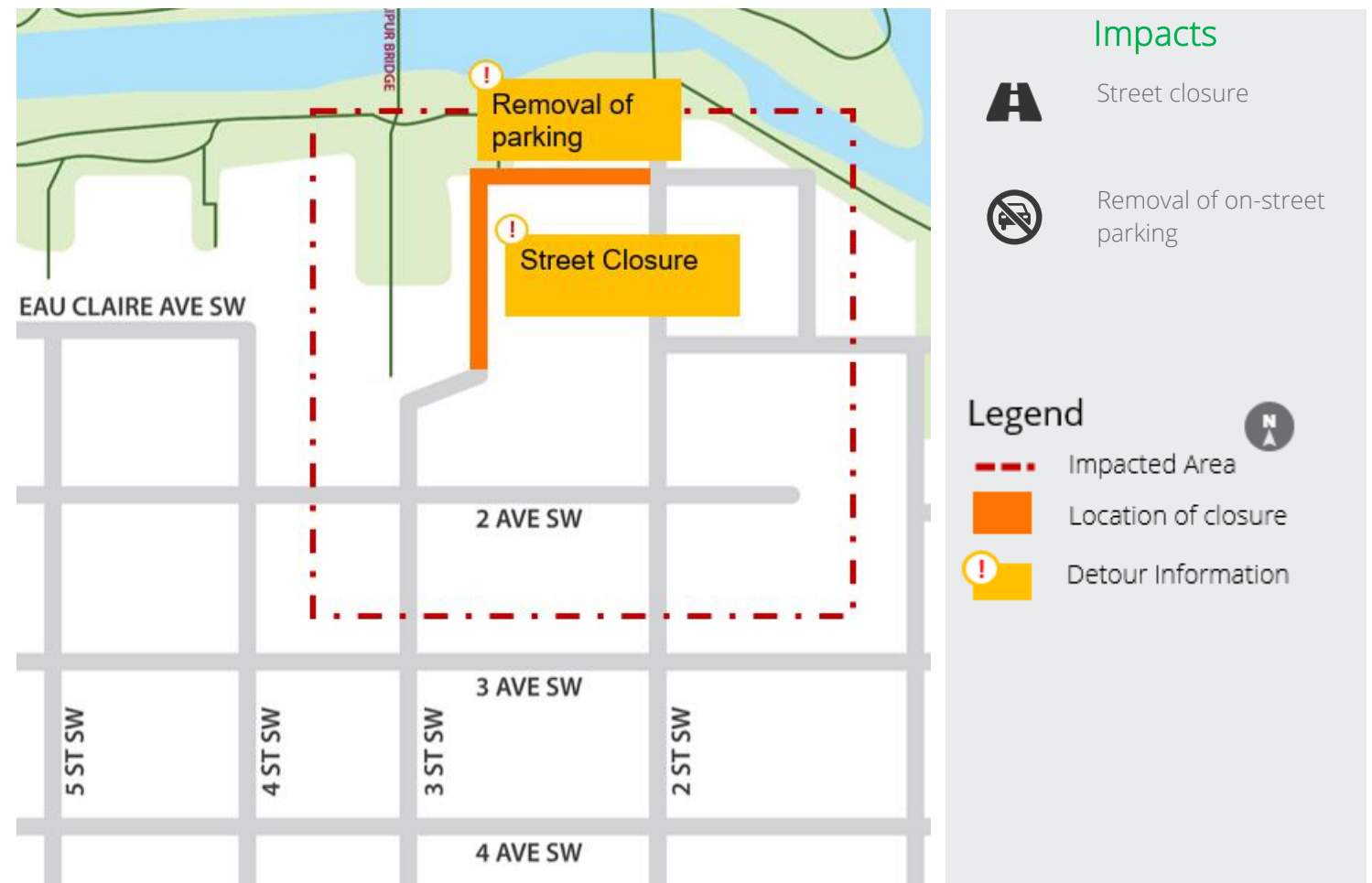

What is the work? Permanent closure of Barclay Parade S.W.

Green Line is beginning to mobilize the Eau Claire site for demolition. To begin this work, Barclay Parade between 2 Street S.W. to north of the Local Public Eatery will be permanently closed.

- Street will be closed.

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$6.248 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Lynnwood/Millican to Eau Claire.
