



Shaw Cable Pulling – 1 St SW and Centre St S – **Night Work**

Notice Date: August 27, 2024

Starting September 3, 2024, Shaw will be pulling cable along 1 Street SW and Centre Street S. This will require the closure of one southbound lane of 1 Street SW from 6 Avenue to 11 Avenue, as well as one northbound lane of Centre Street S from 6 Avenue to 8 Avenue, **weekdays 9pm – 5am**.

What is the work? Shaw Cable Pulling – 1 St SW and Centre St S – Night Work

Beginning September 3, Shaw will be accessing manholes to pull cable along 1 Street SW, between 6 Avenue and 11 Avenue, as well as Centre Street S between 6 Avenue and 7 Avenue.

All work will occur overnight, between 9pm and 5am.

Impacts on 1 Street SW

- One southbound lane will be closed between 6 Avenue and 11 Avenue.
- Pedestrians will not be able to cross west to east from the NW corner of the crosswalks at 1 Street SW and 7 Avenue, and 1 Street SW and 8 Avenue.
- On-street parking will be removed on the west side of the street.
- Access to the alleyway between 8 Avenue and 9 Avenue SW will be closed from 9pm to 5am on September 4 and 9. Vehicles that are parked in the alleyway before 9pm will need to request assistance from the onsite construction crew to exit.

Impacts on Centre Street S

- One northbound lane will be closed between 6 Avenue and 8 Avenue.
- Pedestrians will not be able to cross east to west at the NE corner of the crosswalk at Centre Street S and 7 Avenue.
- On-street parking will be removed on the east side of the street.
- Access to the Hyatt Regency Downtown will be maintained.

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$6.2 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Lynnwood/Millican to Eau Claire.
