



## Shaw Cable Pulling – Centre St S – Night Work 9pm – 5am

Starting September 3, 2024, Shaw will be accessing manholes along 1 Street SW and Centre Street S for cable pulling. This will require localized lane closures in multiple locations, **weekdays 9pm – 5am**. This work will also require a partial closure of the alleyway between 10 Avenue and 11 Avenue SW.

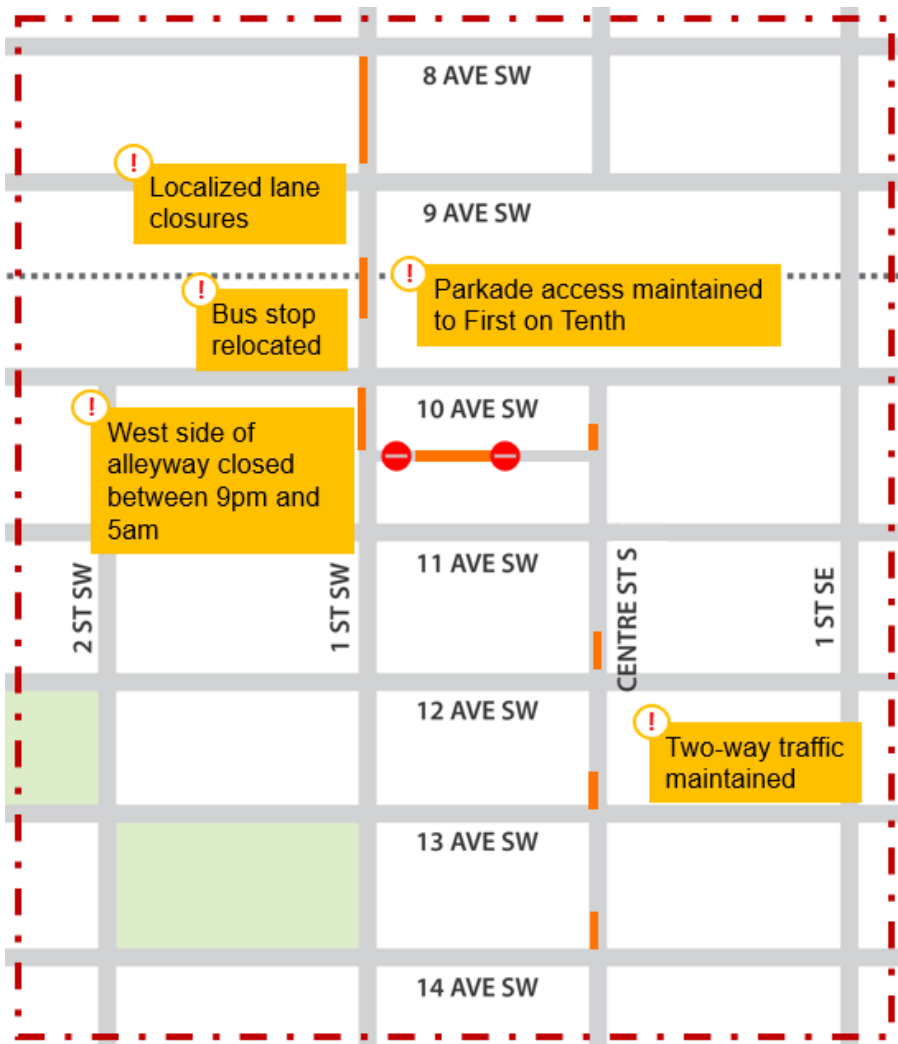

### **What is the work? Shaw Cable Pulling – Centre St S – Night Work**

Beginning September 3, Shaw will be accessing manholes to pull cable in multiple locations along 1 Street SW and Centre Street S.

### **All work will occur overnight on weekdays, between 9pm and 5am.**

#### What to expect

- Pedestrian detours.
- Bus stops relocated along 1 Street SW.
- Localized lane closures.
- On-street parking will be removed.

In addition to these impacts, the west end of the alleyway between 10 Avenue and 11 Avenue (please see map) will be closed. Access will be maintained to the First on Tenth parkade.

### **About Green Line LRT**

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$6.2 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Lynnwood/Millican to Eau Claire.
