# CDHI Utility Relocation – Phase I – Weekends

Notice Date: August 29, 2024

As part of Phase I of CDHI utility relocation, a full closure of 5 Avenue between 1 and 3 Street S.W. and 2 Street between 5 and 6 Avenue S.W. will be in place on back-to-back weekends. The closures will begin at 8pm on Friday until Monday at 5am. Access to loading docks and parkades on 5 Avenue between 2 and 3 Street S.W. will be maintained with the assistance of flaggers. Parkades on 5 Avenue S.W., between 1 and 2 St S.W. can be accessed by southbound traffic on 1 Street S.W.

## What is the work? CDHI Utility Relocation - Phase I Weekend Closures

Back-to-back weekend closures of 5 Avenue between 1 and 3 Street SW and 2 Street between 5 and 6 Avenue SW are required – September 6-9 and September 13-16. The closures will begin at 8pm on Friday until Monday at 5am.

#### Impacts on 5 Avenue SW

- North-south crosswalks closed at 5 Avenue and 2 Street S.W.
- Bus stops along 5 Avenue S.W. will be relocated.

- Full closure of 5 Avenue between 1 and 3 Street S.W.
- Access to loading docks and parkades on 5 Avenue, between 2 and 3 Street S.W. will be maintained.
- Entry to the Bow Valley Square parkade and Fifth Avenue Place parkade can be accessed by southbound traffic on 1 Street S.W.
- A temporary accessible parking and loading zone will be located on 3 Street S.W.

#### Impacts on 2 Street SW

- Closure of west sidewalk between 6 and 7 Avenue S.W.
- Full closure of 2 Street between 5 and 6 Avenue S.W.
- 1 northbound lane open between 6 and 7 Avenue S.W.
- No vehicle access between 4 and 5 Avenue S.W.

The Green Line is Calgary's next light rail transit (LRT) line. With \$6.2 billion in commitments from the Government of Canada, Government of Alberta and City of Calgary, it is the largest infrastructure investment in our city's history.

The current work in Beltline and Downtown is part of the utility relocation program required to make way for Phase 1 construction from Lynnwood/Millican to Eau Claire.
