



Calls for Downtown Safety Response




Calgary Fire Overdose Response

Immigrant Youth Crime Prevention Project

Supports immigrant, newcomer, and refugee youth in developing a sense of belonging to school and the community, navigating strained family relationships, and positive lifestyle choices to prevent their involvement in crime and foster a healthy adjustment to Canada.



2023 Outcome Data

Youth in the program increased their sense of independence by 80% and their sense of mastery by 73%.

Work is already underway or planned for all 28 recommendations, with 11 expected to be completed within the year.

Wise Whiskers Pet Safety Workshop: This <u>interactive workshop</u> increases safe interactions between animals and children and reduces the risk of injury. Pilot sessions are currently underway in select schools from March – June 2024.
