Dear Resident/Property,

The City of Calgary and our contractor, ALSA Road Construction Ltd. will be beginning construction along the north side of 1 Avenue N.E. between 8A and 9A Street N.E. as part of the Bridgeland Main Streets project.


Due to the changes in geometry of various intersections during this project, bus traffic will need to be detoured along 11 Street N.E. and parking along 2 Ave NE and 11 Street N.E. will be temporarily impacted.

During this stage of construction, street parking will temporarily not be permitted on:

- The east side of 11 Street between 1 Avenue to 2 Avenue N.E.
- The north side of 2 Avenue between 8A Street to 11 Street N.E.
- The west side of 8A Street between 1 Avenue to 2 Avenue N.E.

These temporary street parking restrictions on these streets are necessary to ensure sufficient road width is available for detoured bus traffic to safely navigate along this detour route during construction.

Temporary lane closures along 1 Avenue N.E. and temporary parking restrictions as stated above are expected to begin **Monday, September 9.** The anticipated duration of these measures is approximately 2 months. Please note that these dates are subject to change, and we will provide updates as necessary.
