Construction Updates

Sunnyside Flood Barrier- Upcoming Tree Removals

The City will be removing 200-250 trees along the north side of the Bow River on Memorial Dr.

Why do we need to remove trees? The removal of trees is always a last resort, but in this case is required to ensure the flood barrier is constructed safely and to protect the communities of Kensington and Sunnyside. Before construction, crews assessed the health of each tree on site, finding that many trees are nearing the end of their lifecycle. We are also reviewing the tree proximity to construction activity to ensure long-term viability of the trees once the construction is complete.

Replanting trees: The City plans to revitalize the area, by replanting trees and replacing trees in poor condition or affected by construction. We will be planting 250 new trees, including 70 Memorial Poplar clones, and repurposing removed trees for habitats and materials.

Anticipated schedule: Tree removal will take place starting in early February and is anticipated to take three to four weeks to complete. Find more information on this work here.

Gladstone Connect- Upcoming Road Closure

Location: Kensington Road N.W. westbound will be closed between 10A St and 11 A St N.W.

Closure & detour information:

- Westbound traffic will be detoured along 10 St to 5 Ave N.W. westbound for the duration of this work.
- Eastbound lanes will be reduced to single lane traffic for the duration of this work.

Anticipated schedule: Jan 25- Jan 26

19 St N.W. Mobility Improvements:

In 2025, The City will begin construction on a new project in the Riley Area.

The 19 St N.W. Mobility Improvements will improve safety, add active modes and public realm improvements to the community of West Hillhurst.

Project highlights include:

Introducing wider sidewalks and dedicated wheeling lanes by widening

the street.

Adding curb extensions where possible.
